New Provincial Directive on Cell Phones in Schools

- What does this mean for students at our school now?
 - Students may still carry a cell phone to and from school if necessary.
 - During class time the cell phones must be turned off and stored out of sight. They are not allowed in the classroom.
- This directive also applies to other personal mobile



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devices that can be used to perform similar functions including the Vtech watches, portable gaming consoles, MP3 players and iPods,etc.

- Students in grades PP-6 will turn off and store their cell phones for the entire school day, including non-instructional times.
- At no time are cell phones permitted in washrooms.
- Parents and Guardians will need to call the office at 902-462-6010 to pass along important messages
- Please note: If a student needs to call home, they are welcome to **get the office pass** from their teacher and ask the office if they can use the phone.
- **A reminder that we will not be organizing after school plans (playdates) nor will be allowing students to call home and organize them.**
- If your child wants to go to someone's house after school they must organize that before school. Any change in drop off or pick up **MUST** be communicated directly with the teacher AND the office (cres@hrce.ca).
- Please remember that schools are a busy place. If you need to change drop off or pick up plans for your child – **please call the main office in plenty of time.**
