UPDATE FOR CHILD ABUSE REGISTRY PROCESS

This week, the Province announced updates to the Child Abuse Register (CAR) check that moved the process fully online. This means those who need a CAR for work or volunteering can now receive their confirmation online in as little as three business days. The new digital search confirmation replaces the traditional confirmation letters, which could take up to three weeks by mail.

Other changes to the register include:

- Applicants will receive an email notification that the process is complete, at which point they can access their results online
- Applicants can forward the confirmation email to an employer or volunteer organization
- Organizations will verify the search result using the applicant's submission number and date of birth
- Access to digital results expire after 90 days
