Read&Write for Google is a literacy support extension that offers text-to-speech, word prediction, picture dictionaries, and other tools that make digital reading and writing more accessible. It helps students—especially those with learning disabilities—by reducing cognitive load, supporting decoding and comprehension, and giving them multiple pathways to demonstrate their thinking with
