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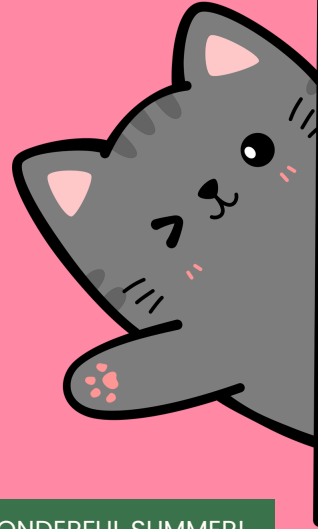
Next year we will be having the opportunity for students to register for Artshine. This is an art program that will be run during lunch time for grades 3-6 once a week for 6 weeks (up to 20 students)

Our art instructors enhance the school's curriculum by conducting art lessons on-site, with lunch time art programs available for **Grades 3-6**.

- Artshine is a parent-paid program. It is \$17.25 per class x 6 classes.
- We offer flexible and cost-effective options for communities that need support.
- Small classes. Each class has a maximum of 20 students per Instructor.
- **Registration is all online.**
- All instructors are certified and have their checks to work with children and are trained to engage your child's creativity.
- Once information is sent out in September, there will be a 15% early bird running all September
