Assessment Consultation and SAC Feedback

Mr. Morrison shared information about the Assessment Consultation that is happening

Principal's Report

Technology Upgrades

Grades P-3 received a new equipment rollout in November. Staff members have received PD and are beginning to use the items in their classrooms. Dalhousie University SuperNova will be doing coding workshops with lower elementary students on January 22 and 23. The Chromebooks are beginning to be used more in grades 2 and 3 and we expect that there will be a demand soon for more equipment,

PTO Funding Support

• The family skate on January 2 was a great success. The PTO continues to provide great support for classroom resources and extracurricular activities.

SAC Budget

70% of funding has been made available (\$3709.00). PTO has already provided funding
for IPads for grade P-2 but more are needed. There is also a need to purchase more
Chromebooks for the tech cart as it does not have a full class set. The initial funding will
be used to enhance technology. When the rest of the funds are made available we will
discuss where it should be spent.

 Primary registration begins on February 1. It is important to spread the word throughout the community because our grade primary numbers help to determine our staffing for September.
